Schedule: Wednesday, January 29, 2025, 4:00-7:00p, Warm-up begins at 3:45pm

Warm-up Fifteen (15) minutes allowed prior to the start of first frame

Uniform: All players and coaches shall appear in appropriate matching tops and bottoms for their school bowling uniform. All team members must be similarly dressed. Slacks, hemmed shorts, skirts and collared sport shirts with a commercially lettered school name and logo on the back are acceptable team apparel. Athletes may not compete in jeans or sweats. Individual names allowed on the front of the shirt only. No Hats allowed.

Conduct of Coaches and Players: The head coach shall be the official team representative for all communications with tournament officials. Only two coaches and qualified team members are allowed in the team seating or lane playing area (or one coach and scorekeeper). The total number shall not exceed seven per team.

2025 SeaKing District 2 Tournament (State-Qualifier):

1A/2A - On January 29th, Chief Sealth, Nathan Hale, Cleveland, Evergreen and Tyeer will compete for a chance to advance to the State Championships. Here, we will play two (2) regular games, and 5 baker games.

3A - On January 29th, all 8 teams from Metro and Highline High School will compete for a chance to advance to the State Championship. Here, we will play two (2) regular games, and 5 baker games.

State-Championships

1A/2A - The top 2 teams and top 4 individual bowlers advance to the State Championships and will take place on February 7th & 8th at Bowlero in Tukwila, WA.

3A - The top 3 teams and top 7 individual bowlers advance to the State Championships and will take place on February 5th & 6th at Bowlero in Tukwila, WA.

Pass Gate Admissions requirements:

- Accepted passes: Metro League Coaches pass, 2024-25 Coaches Association, SEA-King and WIAA Lifetime.
- Press must show proper credentials and sign in.
- Each participating school will submit a gate prior to arrival at pass gate to cover athletes, coaches, managers, bus drivers and trainers.
- School media with League Identification pass will be admitted without charge at the pass gate.

Meet Arrangements and Provisions

Regular Game: A regular game consists of 5 bowlers bowling ten frames alternating lanes each frame. The cumulative point total of the 5 bowlers determines the team score.

Baker Game: A baker game consists of 5 bowlers alternating frames, each bowling two frames (1 & 6, 2 & 7, 3 & 8, 4 & 9, 5 & 10) to determine the baker score. Teams do not alternate lanes until after the 10th frame of the first baker game.

- **Tie Procedure:** If two or more individuals/teams tie for eliminating position, they will bowl 9th and 10th frame roll-off. In the event of a tie for an individual alternate, the bowler with the higher league average will win the tie. Must be present for the roll-off frame or will forfeit the position.
- **Open Substitutions:** Open substitutions allowed at any time during a regular game. If a substitute enters in the middle of a game, the substitute must assume the score of the competitor she is replacing. The score will not be assigned to anyone and the original competitor cannot re-enter that game. All substitutions must be noted on the scorecard. The same substitution rule applies to the Baker games.
- Official school banners (made of cloth or vinyl) will be the only sign permitted.
