<u>Seeding Criteria</u>

Seeding for the tournament will be based on:

- Head-to-Head Match
- State Placer
- State Participant
- Total Wins
- Win Percentage

Weigh-in Procedures

- National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA Regional Tournaments.
- Electronic scales will be used for weigh-ins and should expedite the process.
- Officials will be available at the weigh-ins for skin checks. We will run at least three scales during weigh-in.
- Wrestlers receive 2 lbs allowance for Friday and 3 lbs allowance for Saturday.
- Wrestlers must bring their ID with them to weigh-ins as well as Current and Complete physician notes for possible issues.
- There will be only one entry and exit to the weigh-in area and coaches will be the only ones to enter and leave the area until the wrestlers have weighed in.
- All wrestlers must weigh-in on Friday and pass skin checks on Saturday as well.

Tournament Points

The top eight (8) placers in each weight class earn points at the following ratio:

Medals will be awarded to champions in each weight class.

<u>Awards</u>

Individual First Place at each weight will receive a medal from WIAA District One. All state qualifiers will receive a state qualifying ribbon. A championship team trophy will be awarded.

Qualifying for State

Ten wrestlers will advance to state. We will wrestle through 12th place.

<u>Press</u>

Members of the working media and press photographers who wish to cover the event will be admitted, but need to check-in at the pass gate with appropriate credentials.

Programs

Spectators can follow the tournament on TrackWrestling.

Concessions

Oak Harbor Boosters will offer concessions.

Hospitality Room

A hospitality room will be available for event workers, participation coaches and officials

<u>Apparel</u>

Ashley's Design will provide wrestling apparel.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be provided. Individuals will need to provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care. Oak Harbor School District will not assume responsibility for lost/stolen items.

Tournament Rules

W.I.A.A. tournament rules will apply. (i.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)

Floor Restrictions

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- Only two coaches and a scorer per school at a mat. Wrestlers not wrestling may not sit in the coach's area.
- Only the official photographer will be allowed in the wrestling mat areas
- Outside photographers and Video Cameras- will not be allowed in the mat areas. **Please** inform parents that they will not be allowed to photograph in the wrestling area.
- No one will be permitted to stand along the mats, including coaches, wrestlers and spectators.

Injured Wrestlers

A wrestler removed from participation in a tournament match due to an injury, shall not be allowed to continue until authorized by the medical authority that made the original decision at that tournament, or his/her designee. Decisions by the medical authority are final.

<u>Trainers</u>

Athletic Trainers will be provided by Oak Harbor training staff. Schools are more than welcome to send their own trainers.

General Coaches Reminders

- Each coach is responsible for the conduct of his/her wrestlers and parents.
- Each team and individuals will be responsible for their own valuables.
- There will be no bands at the wrestling tournament.
- No signs other than the official school banner may be displayed or posted.
- No noise makers will be allowed.

Protest

Protest filed by a representative of the school (i.e. coach or administrator, etc.) will be presented to the Tournament Director, who will then confer with the Tournament Games Committee. Their decision will be final and may not be appealed. Parents or other non-school persons may not file a protest. Parents are not allowed to be involved in the protest with the games committee.

WIAA Ejection Rule

W.I.A.A. EJECTION RULE Wrestlers barred from all further competition (remainder of Sub-Regionals, and the Regional and State Tournament) if:

- EJECTED FOR FIRST instance of Flagrant Misconduct (Federation Rule)
- EJECTED FOR SECOND instance of Unsportsmanlike Conduct (Federation Rule) of an "abusive" nature (W.I.A.A. standard).
