Wrestling Starts at 10:00 am

We will wrestle straight through and utilize 4 mats through the finals.

#### **WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES**

- National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA Regional Tournaments.
- Electronic scales will be used for weigh-ins and should expedite the process.
- Officials will be available at the weigh-ins for skin checks. We will run at least three (3) scales during weigh-in.
- Wrestlers receive 2 lbs allowance.
- Wrestlers must bring their ID with them to weigh-ins.
- There will be only one entry and exit to the weigh-in area and coaches will be the only ones to enter and leave the area until the wrestlers have weighed in.

#### **FLOOR RESTRICTIONS**

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- Only two coaches and a scorer per school at a mat. Wrestlers not wrestling may not sit in the coach's area.
- Only the official photographer will be allowed in the wrestling mat areas.
- Outside photographers and video cameras will not be allowed in the mat areas. Please inform parents that they will need to remain up in the bleachers and that they will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.
- No one will be permitted to stand along the mats, including coaches, wrestlers and spectators.

#### **GENERAL COACH REMINDERS**

- Each coach is responsible for the conduct of his/her wrestlers and parents.
- Each team and individuals will be responsible for their own valuables.
- There will be no bands at the wrestling tournament.
- No noise makers will be allowed.

- 2. Coaches will forward a pass list (attached) for participants and 8 support personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, trainers, etc.) to Rosa Maldonado, Monroe Athletic Secretary no later than Thursday, February 6th.
- 3. Cheer staff <u>in uniform</u> will be admitted free. However, each school will be limited to a maximum of four on the mat side during matches. <u>Each school will be limited to 8 cheerleaders</u>, who are to be listed on the attached pass list.

# **AWARDS**

Individual First Place at each weight will receive a medal from WIAA District One. All state qualifiers will receive a state qualifying ribbon.

#### **STATE QUALIFIERS**

We will set up a "true 4th" in Trackwrestling, ensuring that if the 5th and 4th place wrestlers haven't faced each other, they will compete at the end of the tournament on February 8th. The 5th place finishers from each District 1 Tournament will then wrestle off the next week to determine the final state qualifier and alternate. The top 4 finishers in each weight class will qualify for the WIAA State Tournament at the Tacoma Dome on Thursday, February 20th, and Friday, February 21st.

#### LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be provided. Individuals will need to provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care. Monroe School District will not assume responsibility for lost/stolen items.

#### **HOSPITALITY ROOM**

A hospitality room will be available for event workers, participating coaches and officials.

#### TRAINERS/FIRST AID

Athletic Trainers will be provided by Monroe High School training staff. Schools are more than welcome to send their own trainers. Please have your teams bring medical kits stocked with tape.

#### **DISPUTES/PROTESTS**

Protest filed by a representative of the school (i.e. coach or administrator, etc.) will be presented to the Tournament Director, who will then confer with the Tournament Games Committee. Their decision will be final and may not be appealed. Parents or other non-school persons may not file a protest. Parents are not allowed to be involved in the protest with the games committee.
