The top six (6) placers in each weight class earn points at the following ratio:

1st place: 16 points
2nd place: 12 points
3rd place: 9 points
4th place: 7 points
5th place: 5 points
6th place: 3 points

## **WEIGH-IN**

NFHS Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used.

Electronic scales will be used for weigh-ins.

Officials will be available at the weigh-ins for skin checks.

Wrestlers receive a 2-pound postseason allowance.

Once wrestling begins, a mat room is available for warm-ups.

# **FLOOR RESTRICTIONS**

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators are not allowed in the wrestling areas.

- Only two coaches and a scorer per school at a mat.
- Wrestlers not wrestling may not sit in the coach's area.

# **INJURED WRESTLERS**

A wrestler removed from participation in a tournament match due to an injury shall not be allowed to continue until authorized by the medical authority that made the original decision at that tournament or his/her desinee. Decisions by the medical authority are final.

# **PROTEST**

Protest filed by a representative of the school will be presented to the Tournament Director who will then confer with the Tournament Committee. Their decision will be final and may not be appealed. Parents or other non-school persons may not file a protest.

- 2. Ejected for second instance of un-sportsmanlike conduct of an "abusive nature".
