## Getting to Olympia High School

- Olympia High School's address is 1302 North Street SE, Olympia 98501. DO NOT GO TO THIS ADDRESS; you will be on the wrong side.
- Teams and spectators should enter on the north side of the building which is Carlyon Street, not North Street. Carlyon runs between Henderson Boulevard and Capital Boulevard. The school **sign** on Carlyon reads William Winlock Miller High School, but you will be arriving at Olympia HS and will see Olympia High School above the main entrance. Look for sandwich boards to direct you to the event entrance.
- If using GPS, you can navigate to Pioneer Elementary 1655 Carlyon Ave SE, Olympia, WA 98501. Once you get to the elementary school, continue on Carlyon to Olympia High School.
