# A. TOURNAMENT CONTACTS/MANAGER

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#### **B. QUALIFYING TEAMS**

- 1. The tournament will be a modified 12-team bracket
  - a. The number of league entrants is determined by WIAA allocations
    - i. The top 8 teams from Kingco will qualify for the 2024 WesKing tournament
    - ii. The top 4 teams from Wesco will qualify for the 2024 WesKing tournament
  - b. For seeding purposes, each league will determine the order of finish of their teams
- 2. The top 6 placing teams from the WesKing tournament will qualify for the WIAA state tournament

#### C. TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

#### All Games will be played at the higher seed and on artificial turf

Note: with prior approval of the WesKing committee, games times may be adjusted to accommodate facilities, double-headers or other time conflicts.

#### D. GAMES COMMITTEE

- 1. Each host site will establish a games committee consisting of the following
  - a. Game Manager (at local site)
  - b. Head Official
  - c. Tournament contact from non-host league or their designee (available by phone)
- 2. If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question, and prior to resumption of play, that the contest is under protest.
  - a. The official will suspend the contest until the decision of the games committee has been determined
  - b. The games committee will immediately meet
  - c. The coach will be provided the opportunity to present a rationale and justification, including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the officials and desired outcome.
  - d. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session
  - e. The decision of the Games Committee is final

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#### E. SCHOOL ROSTERS

- 1. Roster must be entered on the WPA website by noon on Thursday, October 26
- 2. Team rosters will serve as a school's pass list
- 3. Roster will include the following bench personnel
  - a. Maximum of 22 athletes
  - b. Maximum of 6 team personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, video, etc)
  - c. Maximum 1 trainer/health care provider
- 4. Changes to rosters are allowed between each round of the tournament
  - a. Updated rosters shall be entered on the WPA website no later than 10 am of game day
- 5. Rosters should include Superintendent and School Board Members
- 6. Supervisors should use a District's Supervisor pass, as listed below, for admission to the contest

#### F. OFFICIALS

1. Officials will be assigned by WOA assignors prior to the start of the tournament

### G. SOCCER BALLS

- 1. The host site will be responsible to supply 3 game balls
- 2. Each school will furnish its own warmup soccer balls

### H. UNIFORMS

- 1. NFHS requirements will be followed
- 2. The home team will wear dark uniforms. The visiting team will wear white uniforms.

### I. DRESSING FACILITIES

- 1. Dressing/locker rooms will be available
- 2. Do not leave valuables in the dressing/locker room
- 3. Teams will be responsible for disposing of garbage and ensuring dressing areas are left clean

# J. WARM-UPS

- 1. Fields will be available for warm-ups a minimum of 60 minutes prior to game time
- 2. In the event of a double-header, a minimum of 20 minutes of warm-up time will be provided prior to the start of game #2.

# K. LENGTH OF PERIODS

- 1. Regulation time will consist of two halves of 40 minutes each
  - a. The clock operator will stop the clock at 2:00 each half, with official game time being kept on the field
  - b. The referee will indicate to both coaches as to how much time remains
- 2. Half time shall be 10 minutes in length

# L. TIE GAMES

- 1. If the game is tied at the end of regulation, 2 five minute "golden goal" periods will be played
  - a. A five minute break will be given to both teams prior to the first overtime.
  - b. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends
- 2. If a tie remains after the two 5 minute periods, each team will take five penalty kicks
  - a. Each coach will select 5 players to kick. Only players on the field of play at the end of the match are eligible to take the penalty kicks.
  - b. Each team will alternate penalty kicks until each team has completed 5 penalty kicks or until a team can be declared winner.

3. If a tie remains after each team has taken 5 penalty kicks, teams shall select 5 different players and will continue taking penalty kicks until each team has taken the same number of kicks and one team has scored one more goal than the other.

#### N. PASSES

  - e. District One and Kingco "Lifetime Passes"

#### **O. FINANCES**

1. Completion of financial documents and deposit of funds will be according to the District/League procedures of the host site.

#### P. GENERAL RULES

- 1. School supervisors are responsible for encouraging and enforcing good sportsmanship
- 2. Artificial noise makers are not allowed
- 3. Signs are prohibited. An official school banner is allowed.
- 4. Announcements made over the public address system must be directly related to the event in progress. All other announcements must first be cleared by the game manager.
- 5. Each team is responsible for picking up their trash and equipment and leaving their team area clean

# Q. HOST SITE BULLETIN

- 1. Each host site will develop a specific game bulletin to be shared with the visiting school(s) and will include the following:
  - a. Game location with any specific entrance or parking directions and drop offs
  - b. Game manager and contact information
  - c. Games committee members (see item C, above)
  - d. On site availability of medical staff/athletic trainer
  - e. Site specific guidelines (field access time, team dressing facilities, seating, introductions, field restrictions, etc)
  - f. Concession's availability
  - g. Link to GoFan ticket purchases host site is responsible to ensure tickets have been added to GoFan
