## Pass Gate Admission Requirements

- Accepted passes: Coaches Association, Officials Association, SeaKing, WIAA Lifetime
- Each participating school will submit a gate list to the Tournament Manager prior to arrival at the pass gate to cover players, managers, trainers, and statisticians. Participating teams in the playoff will be admitted by Roster. Only 22 players, 6 coaches and managers and 2 supervisors directly involved in the game are to be included on the roster. **A copy of the roster is to be emailed as an attachment to Pat McCarthy by Friday, November 7 at noon.**
- School photographers and school press (one each) with League Identification pass will be admitted without charge at the pass gate.

## Team Rosters

- Three copies of the team roster are to be given to the Tournament Manager one-half hour prior to game time. This roster is to have the starting line-up indicated.
- A team roster is to be given to the opposing coach, referee, and announcer prior to the start of the contest.

## Concessions

- No concession will be available

## Officials

- Officials will be provided by the WA Soccer Referee Association.

## **Soccer Balls**

- Providing three (3) match soccer balls (NFHS approved) will be the responsibility of the designated home team. Each school will furnish its own warm-up soccer balls. The home team will supply two (2) ball holders.

## **Uniforms**

- District 2 teams will be the home teams for both games.
- The home team will wear dark uniforms and the visiting team will wear white uniforms. Teams are responsible to bring both colored jerseys in case there is a conflict.

## **Shoes**

- No metal cleats are allowed on the turf.

## **Dressing Rooms**

- Teams should come dressed in uniform. Dressing rooms will be provided upon request. Requests must be made to Tournament Manager prior to the event.

## **Warm-ups**

- The field will be open for warm-up 30 minutes prior to the first game. A minimum of 20 minutes will be provided for warm-up before any game.

## **Tied Games**

- If a game ends in a tie after regulation time is completed, no more than two 5-minute "Golden Goal" overtime periods will be played.
- If a tie still exists, a penalty shootout will determine the winner of the game with each team shooting five (5) penalty kicks.
  - Only players who were on the field at the conclusion of regulation time may be selected to participate in the penalty shootout.
  - Penalty kicks shall not continue after a team has scored enough goals to win.
- If a tie still exists after each team has taken five penalty kicks, the shootout will continue with each team taking one penalty kick at a time until one team has scored one goal more than the other.
