Driving Directions to Curtis High School and Curtis Junior High

Take I-5 to the 56th Avenue exit West Travel West on 56th Street (it will become Cirque Drive) for approximately 3.25 miles to Bridgeport Way. Turn right and proceed to 40th Street. Turn left onto 40th Street and travel west through a 4-way stop and down the hill. Curtis High School is on the right hand side. The team bus will turn right into the second drive past the CHS reader board and drop athletes and coaches in front of the main gym and aquatic center.

Stadium High School

From I-5 Tacoma take the I-705 North/WA-7 exit, exit number 133, towards City Center/Mt Rainier
Keep right at the fork in the ramp
Keep left at the fork in the ramp
Merge onto I-705 North, towards City Center
Take the Schuster Pkwy exit on the right
Keep right at the fork on the ramp
Take the Stadium Way exit at the fork
Turn right onto Stadium Way

Officials

The officiating organization will provide all officials to include game officials, line judges, libero trackers and scorers. Tournament director will provide scoreboard operators for all courts.

GO FAN - ONLINE TICKETS ONLY - NO CASH SALES

League Passes will NOT be accepted.

Seeding Committee, West Central District, Washington State Coaches Association (WSCA) and Washington Secondary School Athletic Administrator passes will be honored at the pass gate.

Students may not leave and re-enter the gym during the event.

No outside food or drink

No student backpacks

Signs and School Banners

No signs other than the official school banners will be allowed in the gyms.

Filming

There are a limited number of electrical outlets available around the bleachers. Please bring plenty of battery power. No extension cords will be run across walkways. Each team may have one videographer. Check with officials for an approved location.

Team Spaces and Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be available 45 minutes prior to the contest. You will need to take your belongings to the bench prior to the game. This will allow for the next team to use the locker room. Locker rooms will **NOT** be available after the match.

Warm up area: The lower and upper hallways (without blocking spectator traffic) may be used for waiting teams to space out and stretch prior to most matches. **No balls** should be used in the hallways. Please take care of your own garbage.

Officials/Game Staff - Hospitality Room

A room will be available to officials and game staff & Coaches

Cheerleaders

Admitted only in uniform and must remain in the designated area. No more than 8 cheerleaders will be admitted in uniform, and they will need to cheer from the spectator stands.

Game Ball

Game balls will be provided by the host sites.

Team Benches

The team benches will be designated by the site managers.

Pre-Match Warm-up

The coin flip, 8 shared, 6-6 warm-up (serving included) procedure will be followed. Visiting team warms up first. There will be a twenty-minute minimum time period between the end of the last match and the start of the warm-up period when teams are playing consecutive matches.

Sportsmanship:

Sportsmanship pins will be awarded at the conclusion of each match to a player, fan, student or whomever from each team, who shows positive sportsmanship.

- The official school banner will be the only sign permitted.
- ALL noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors.
- The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.
- Balloons will not be allowed.

- Derogatory and targeting comments will not be tolerated.
- All players, coaches and fans are expected to honor the game by being positive and encouraging.

Tournament Rules:

2023 National Federation rules will be used with these exceptions:

- Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 games. First four games to 25 and fifth game to 15 with no cap.
- Each school will furnish their own warm-up balls.

Designation of Home Team

The home team will be the bottom team of each bracket and will warm up second.

Player Introductions

Introductions will only be made prior to the start of the championship match. After the introduction, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Games Committee

Each Tournament Director shall appoint and name a Games Committee for all postseason contests. Duties of the Games Committee shall be as follows:

- Assist the Tournament Director as needed and be immediately available to him/her during the event.
- Act as an arbitration board of dispute on questions or protests that might arise. The final decision will be the consensus of the Games Committee.
- Questions concerning infractions may be brought to the Games Committee by a coach or person in charge of a team, not by a contestant.
- The Games Committee shall be composed of no fewer than three and not more than five members.
- The Games Committee members may not be involved with the game under dispute and should be composed of:
 - Tournament Manager
 - Coach, Athletic Director, or School Administrator
 - Head Official
 - West Central District Director, Joe Keller - 253.225.1761

Medical Services

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to the needs of athletes before, during and after the games. Trainer will be stationed at Stadium High School and be available by radio throughout the event.
