To provide the best tournament conditions possible, all athletic directors and head coaches must read and follow the procedures outlined in this syllabus. We ask that when you enter the facilities at either location that your entire team and coaching staff enter together. All supervisors or additional pass gate individuals be submitted on team rosters or on the WIAA pass gate through Final Forms.

Roster and Eligibility

You will need to complete your roster online at the WIAA website by Wednesday, November 6th. We will take rosters off the WPA site. If these are not correct, please let me know.

Team Entry

Each team may have a roster of 14 players and 6 coaches/managers. No exceptions. No one other than those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench. All players/coaches and managers must enter together through main gym entrance.

Passes

League and season passes will not be honored. WSSAAA, WSCA and WCD Executive Board passes are the only type that will be accepted.

Gate Pass List Form

Administrators or Faculty only on the WIAA supervision gate pass list through Final Forms. Faculty supervisors whose names are on the gate list are asked to sit in the section representing their school.

Team Introductions

Only introductions will be for the championship match on Saturday. All players and coaches for both teams will be introduced.

Officials and scorers:

The tournament Director will arrange for officials from the local officiating boards representing the teams within district 3. These officials will serve as game officials and line judges. Assigning secretaries from each board represented determine official assignments. Libero trackers will be provided by each HOME school team in the match. Scoreboard and official book will be staffed by the tournament host.

Game Balls

Game balls will be provided. All game balls will be Baden.

Training Room

Training room facility with ice will be available at Fife HS only. Please bring your own taping supplies, the site will not supply.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms are available on a limited basis.

Cheerleaders

Admitted only in uniform and must remain in the designated area. No more than 8 cheerleaders will be admitted in uniform and they will need to cheer from the spectator stands.

Filming

There are a limited number of electrical outlets available around the bleachers. Please bring plenty of battery power. No extension cords will be run across walkways. No cameras will be set up in the elevated booth in the main gym at Fife HS.

FHS Main Gym has Pixellot and Hudl Focus. Game 11, 12 and 16 will be livestreamed on Pixellot and if your school uses HUDL, you can schedule a direct exchange with Focus. Support for that will not be provided.

General Statements

Bands will not be permitted at the tournament. The official school banner will be the only sign permitted

Any artificial noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors

The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.

Concessions

Concessions will available at the Fife HS location only on both days. NO OUTSIDE FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FACILITY.

Court Assignments:

Court assignments will be drawn by the tournament committee and the tournament director shall have the authority to make adjustments as necessary.

Pre Match Warm-up

Official varsity warm-up procedures for all regular and postseason matches: The official warm-up time will be 20 minutes, with eight (8) minutes of shared court time, followed by six (6) minutes for the visiting team, followed by six (6) minutes for the home team. Hitting or serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared court time. Teams are not allowed to warm-up on the sidelines or end lines while waiting for their court time.

Tournament Rules:

2024 National Federation rules will be used with these exceptions:

Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 games. First four games to 25 and fifth game to 15 with no cap.

Each school will furnish their own warm-up balls. Match balls will be furnished by the tournament manager.

Designation of Home Team

The home team will be the higher seed of each bracket and warms up last.

State Program Roster Information

All rosters for the state program must be submitted on-line as per WIAA deadline

Protests

WIAA District volleyball Games Committee: Each Event Manager shall appoint and name a Games Committee for all postseason contests. Duties of the Games Committee shall be as follows:

- 1. Assist the tournament director as needed and be immediately available to him/her at all times during the event.
- 2. Act as an arbitration board of dispute on questions or protests that might arise. The final decision will be the consensus of the Games Committee.
- 3. Questions concerning infractions may be brought to the Games Committee by a coach or person in charge of a team, not by a contestant.
- 4. The Games Committee shall be composed of no fewer than three, nor more than five, members.
- 5. The Games Committee members may not be involved with the game under dispute and should be composed of 1) **event manager**, 2) **coach, athletic director or school administrator**, and 3) **head official**.

Directions and Parking

TEAM BUSES & TEAM VANS

Friday games require specific access to the venues. A bus map has been provided as an attachment.

FHS – Fife Elementary releases at 3:20pm and there is a parent pickup backup that happens in front of the gym and on access roads. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS. All buses on Friday should drop teams on the WEST side of the school and walk through the open gates to the front gym entrance. Bus Parking is marked on the map with the arrow pointing the team to walk through the front of the school. DO NOT ENTER from 58th or on the south side entrance marked with red X's. Bus and van access will be backed up from 2:30-4:00pm.

CJH – The gym entrance is on the southwest end of the school next to the bus parking marked on the map. There should not be any traffic or access issues at this location

Saturday all parking should be on the East side of the school. There will not be issues with access to the parking and the Fife Elementary Bus parking will be available. Access to the front of the school as shown in Friday will be locked.

SPECTATOR PARKING – spectators should park in the stadium/student parking on the southeast side of the school. They can access that lot from the 23rd St on the south side of the school and stadium.

Spectator Expectations

STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, ALL SPECTATORS are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES. Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects.

Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide match supervision and promote a safe enjoyable event for everyone. Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the school policy of no body or face paint, no masks, and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises we will ask you to address it.

DUTIES OF SCHOOL SUPERVISORS

- Report to the event manager at least 30 minutes prior to their team's match.
- Must wear supervisor/school identification so that it is visible and easily seen.
- Sit with your school's student body and fans while your team is competing.
- Be active and visible in the cheering section with your student body and fans during all contests in order to discourage problems.
- Be willing to approach students and/or community members who display inappropriate behavior.
- Notify tournament staff of potential problem individuals.
- Be of assistance as requested by facility security staff or tournament management staff.
- Be sure aisles and stairways are kept clear in the stands.
- Keep your students and fans from entering the court surface.
- Assist in the orderly flow of traffic of fans entering and exiting the facility.
- At the conclusion of your match, assist your school's students and fans in leaving the bleachers.
- Foster the traits of good sportsmanship.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR SMOKING ALLOWED ON SCHOOL PREMISES. This includes vape devices or electronic nicotine devices.
