**Site Details:**

- Saturday, February 15, 2025 & Tuesday, February 18, 2025 games will be played at higher seed district approved sites. February 15<sup>th</sup> games are loser out.
- Games involving schools which recognize Saturday Sabbath will take place on Monday, February 17<sup>th</sup>.
- Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup> games will be played at Muckleshoot Community Center and Evergreen Lutheran. Lummi High School can be a February 20 site if two District 1 teams are involved and both agree to the site, or if the top seeded D1 team is involved and they wish to play at Lummi. Games could also be played at Port Angeles if a higher seeded district 3 team is involved. See posted bracket for game times.
- Saturday, February 22, games will be played at Muckleshoot Community Center. See posted bracket for game times. The gym will open one hour prior to the first game for teams and the ticket gate will open 45 minutes prior to the first game. The floor will be available thirty minutes prior to the first game of the day. No players will be allowed on the game floor until thirty minutes prior to the first game. Warm-up times after the first game will be 15-20 minutes as time allows. Accommodations will be made for schools which recognize Saturday Sabbath.

**Game Locations Procedure:**

- Game locations for Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, will be determined by the Tournament Director in coordination with participating schools ADs, and the other host sites. The process for determining locations will be similar to prior years.
  - In order to have the proper officials at each site, efforts will be made to have two boys games and two girls games at each site. Consideration will be given for the travel time needed to game sites by participating schools.
  - Efforts will be made to place girls and boys teams from the same school at the same site.
  - Consideration will be made to allow host sites to host their own teams in order to facilitate enough workers to host games and to allow their community to attend.
  - Strong consideration will be given to top seeds playing at the site nearer to their school.

Tickets will be sold on site the day of the event or via your district's online ticketing platform. The ticket

gate will open about 45 minutes prior to the first competition. You must get your hand stamped upon leaving the gymnasium if you wish to gain re-entrance into the gymnasium.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: No checks or cash will be accepted for the admission cost. Please communicate this to your fans.**

**Important Tournament Information:**

1. The tournament is a modified double elimination format, with six (6) girls teams and six (6) boys teams advancing to the State 1B Basketball First Round at various sites February 24, February 25, 2025.
2. See the posted Tournament Bracket for specific sites, times, and pairings.
3. The board of directors from District 2 Sea-Tac league will be responsible for the official scorebook, all game workers, and forming a games committee for each neutral site at a District 2 location. They will also be responsible for game announcing. District 1 is responsible for these arrangements at games played at any District 1 site,
4. At home sites, the host school will be responsible for gym arrangements.

**Roster Submission:**

1. Your official Tri-District roster containing the first name, last names, grade, height and position of a maximum of 12 players must be submitted FinalForms and synced to WPAN by Friday, February 8th, 2025. Please enter all data and upload your appropriately formatted team picture.

**Pass Gate Instructions/Complimentary Admissions:** Please enter your Gate List information via FinalForms as instructed on the WIAA website at MyWIAA.

1. Cheerleaders must be in full uniform for complimentary admission.
2. WIAA Lifetime Passes are valid.
3. State Coaches and State Athletic Director Passes are valid.
4. The site manager will use a Pass Gate for each participating school's team members, coaches, and managers. The number to be admitted will be consistent with the WIAA regulations for state competition – 12 team members and 4 coaches, scorekeeper plus 2 bench personnel.
5. The Pass Gate must be completed by Friday, February 14, 2025. Your Pass Gate should be saved and printed and then sent to the Tournament Director and your host site. **Pass Outs:** Pass outs are permitted during the tournament. A hand stamp will be required to return to the tournament gymnasium.

**Press Admission:** Members of the working press and press photographers who wish to cover the tournament will be admitted free. Members of the press wishing to cover the tournament should be prepared to provide appropriate identification upon arrival at the tournament site.

## TOURNAMENT POLICIES

**Supervision:** Participating schools are responsible for the supervision of their students. The Tournament Manager has the authority to stop a contest as a result of unacceptable crowd behavior after conferring with the games committee and the school representatives present. The contest may continue once the Manager has reasonable assurance that the disruptive behavior is under control.

**Cheerleaders:** Cheerleaders must comply with the National Federation safety standards.

**Bands:** Pep bands **will not** be admitted to any Tri-District neutral site game.

**Seating:** Only players, coaches, and bench personnel will be allowed on the team bench or warm-up areas.

**Game and Gymnasium Regulations:**

1. Signs and Confetti, Decorations, Noisemakers, and Laser Pointing Devices.
  - a. Signs other than the school banner are prohibited from display.
  - b. Throwing objects or scattering paper in the stands or on the court and the general school area is prohibited. Any school violating this policy may be assessed a fine for the cost of the cleaning.
  - c. Power air horns and other synthetic noisemakers are strictly prohibited, as are laser pointing devices. Such devices will be impounded and returned to the owner after the tournament. Band instruments are not to be used as noisemakers. Megaphones may be used by cheerleaders only.
2. Use of tobacco products, alcohol or illegal drugs on school premises is prohibited and will subject the offender to potential arrest.
3. Spectators are to remain off the gymnasium playing surface at all times.
4. Locker rooms are for coaches and players only. Participating teams will be assigned a locker room upon their arrival at the host site.

**Officials:** The host schools for the games played on Saturday, February 15, & Tuesday, February 18, should check with their local assignor to assure officials are assigned. The Tournament Director will work with the official assignors to ensure games at Muckleshoot Community Center and other neutral sites are covered.

**Parking:** There is enough space between the Muckleshoot CC, Muckleshoot Health and Wellness parking lots to accommodate the buses.

**Additional Tournament Information and Practices:**

1. Teams will check in the main door of the community center and escorted to their locker room.
2. There will be an athletic trainer on site for games at Muckleshoot Community Center.
3. Please furnish your own taping supplies.
4. The official tournament basketball will be the Baden Perfection Elite Pro.
5. Concessions are the responsibility of the home site schools. All profits are contracted to them. Selling of food or beverage items by those other than the concessionaire will not be permitted.
6. Programs will be the responsibility of the home site schools.
7. Awards: A trophy will be awarded to the first place teams.
8. The Site Manager and Tournament Director are empowered to make any decisions and judgments deemed necessary that are not specifically covered by these instructions.

**Finances:**

1. All member schools that participate in the Tri District Tournament shall share in the profit or loss of the event for games on February 20 and 22, based on the number of games played by each school. The distribution of the profit or loss shall be in accordance with WIAA District policies.
2. Income and expenses shall be handled in accordance with Sea-King District 2 finance policy.
3. Only Board approved expenses will be paid from event income.
